MIAMI, Fla. — Tropical storm Heidi barreled up the Atlantic coastline today, threatening the northeastern United States with more heavy rains, while her older sister Edith drifted on a course that would take her into Mexico.

Whirling over cold waters of the North Atlantic, Heidi weakened rapidly during the night as she passed east of the Nantucket lightship.

"She's now northeast of Cape Cod, pretty well washed out," said forecaster Ray Kraft of the National Hurricane Centre at Miami. "A reconnaissance plane couldn't even find her."
